Protocol on the contents of the seized documents of Nazim Brahimaj

1. DOCUMENT: Nazim BRAHIMAJ' s war diary, booklet, DinA5

1. Entries of the guards of a UCK/TMK base, presumably 3th Coy of the Bn "Sadik SHALA", Div 3 of the 121 Bde "KUMANOVA"

Other entries	Entries on the events and combat actions in the period between 06 May 98 and 10 June 99. The events in the region of BARDHANIP, JABLLANIC, and DUSHKAJ (DN 60 37) are reported.

Note:

The contents of the entries does not result in essential findings.

Apart from the KSHIK document, the other documentation does not contain any essential findings.

The residual documentation comprises:

1. Newspaper articles on UCK, TMK, interviews of BRAHIMAJ, and reports on the KOSOVO crisis.
2. Lawyer's documents concerning various individuals, presumably friends and subordinates.
3. Internet information on the KOSOVO crisis.
4. General TMK documents.
5. Photographs of family and friends (especially the HARADINAJ brothers), and various photographs of TMK members as well as older UCK photographs.
