ISUFI does not seem to display malice toward the Kosovar Serbs. He does not possess the qualities of a particularly effective leader. The Serbian government is reported to have held ISUFI as a political prisoner for nine years and this may have elevated his standing within the PKPC. Although ISUFI is a PKPC member, he is reported to be the GNJILANE (EN 3801) chairman for the Democratic Progress of Kosovo (PPDK). FHT COMMENT: Members of the PKPC are restricted from holding political positions. COMMENT ENDS: It is not thought that ISUFI has ever served in the former Yugoslav


